Copyright issues are increasingly relevant and important to SLHS. They affect the ways in which you use the works of others. They also implicate SLHS itself when employees, physicians, students, staff, volunteers, visiting physicians/students/interns, affiliates, visitors, et al, use the SLHS networks to carry out illegal activities.
